Post Summary

Working with Performance subjects, Music, Drama and Dance.

- Support onstage during shows, which could involve moving set, helping to attach radio mics to actors, or unplugging and moving lighting equipment.
- Clean, maintain and use a range of theatre lighting, sound and video equipment, including radio mics, moving lights and projectors.
- Set up technical systems such as sound PA's, video projectors and lighting rigs.
- Ensure that all workspace and equipment is maintained in a safe condition for use
- To store all equipment and materials in accordance with appropriate legislation and guidelines
- To assist students with practical activities in a range of practical lessons and examinations, and other practical activities, as required, under the guidance of teaching staff.
