Introduction

Under data protection law, individuals have a right to be informed about how processors use any personal data that they hold. We comply with this right by providing 'privacy notices' (sometimes called 'fair processing notices') to individuals where we are processing their personal data.

This privacy notice explains how we collect, store and use personal data about organisations and their staff who are involved in the Sandwell PEIA Project.

We, Shireland Collegiate Academy Trust, process data to fulfil our obligations as part of the project in providing an online portal facilitating the various workstreams and collaboration as part of the PEIA work.

This information is provided in accordance with the rights of individuals under the General Data Protection Regulation; it allows individuals to understand how their data is used. We collect this information to ensure the portal is effectively setup for use of organisations within the project group. This is on the basis of Legitimate Interests of the organisation to use the portal and benefit from the information being developed through it.

How we store this data

We keep all data secure and follow procedures and retention found as part of our Data Protection Policy.

Requesting Access to your Personal Data How to Access the Data we Hold About You

Individuals have a right to make a 'subject access request' to gain access to personal information that the Trust holds about them.

If you make a subject access request, and if we do hold information about you, we will:

- Give you a description of it
- Tell you why we are holding and processing it, and how long we will keep it for
- Explain where we got it from, if not from you
- Tell you who it has been, or will be, shared with
- Let you know whether any automated decision-making is being applied to the data, and any consequences of this
- Give you a copy of the information in an intelligible form

You may also have a right for your personal information to be transmitted electronically to another organisation in certain circumstances.

If you would like to make a request, please contact our data protection officer.

Your Other Rights Regarding Your Data

Under data protection law, individuals have certain rights regarding how their personal data is used and kept safe. You have the right to:

- Object to the use of your personal data if it would cause, or is causing, damage or distress
- Prevent your data being used to send direct marketing
- Object to the use of your personal data for decisions being taken by automated means (by a computer or machine, rather than a person)
- In certain circumstances, have inaccurate personal data corrected, deleted or destroyed, or restrict processing
- Claim compensation for damages caused by a breach of the data protection regulations



To exercise any of these rights, please contact our data protection officer.

Complaints

We take any complaints about our collection and use of personal information very seriously.

If you think that our collection or use of personal information is unfair, misleading or inappropriate, or have any other concern about our data processing, please raise this with us in the first instance.
